This class is designed to provide students with the skills to develop a character and capture the audience's attention from the moment they walk out on stage. Learn how to create stage presence whether they are playing a lead or working it in the chorus. Students will...

- Learn to think on their feet with improvisation
- Work independently on monologues
- Work in small groups on scenes
- Develop audition techniques
- Develop believable, relatable characters through monologues, scenes, & musical performance

All of this will culminate in a final showcase highlighting what they have learned.

Participants must commit to the entire schedule unless the director has granted permission in advance. Less than full participation may limit the participant's opportunities in the final showcase. If granted, there will be no tuition discount for limited participation. Every participant will be in the performance showcase, though no participant is guaranteed a featured or solo performance. Casting decisions will be based on a student's abilities and dedication.
